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








DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Day 1

Embarkation at Lavrion port between 14:00-15:00. Enjoy a refreshing welcome drink during your smooth check-in. We set sail for the nearby Cape Sounion, home to the "Temple of Poseidon" for your first dip in the Aegean waters. Perched at the edge of the cliff, the ancient sanctuary is one of the most important monuments of the golden age of Athens. Dinner onboard. Overnight at anchor.

Day 2

Morning arrival at the island of Delos, the mythical birthplace of God Apollo, a Unesco World Heritage Site of unique energy. Mid-day sailing to the cosmopolitan island of Mykonos. Lunch onboard. Afternoon at leisure to explore the island. Enjoy a sunset drink at Little Venice, photograph the iconic windmills or simply explore the swirling pathways of the white-washed Chora with its many elegant boutiques, cafes, restaurants and clubs. We set sail to Naxos in the early morning hours.

Day 3

Wake up at a beautiful cove in Naxos for a swim-stop before we sail towards the main port. Lunch onboard. Afternoon arrival for a leisurely exploration of Naxos town and its famous "Portara" or join an optional excursion to the Olive Press Museum, a local liquor distillery and the traditional village of Apeiranthos. Overnight at port.

Day 4

Morning sailing to Schinoussa island for a relaxing day swimming, kayaking and enjoying lunch onboard. In the afternoon, we sail to tranquil Ano Koufonisi for a guided walking/photography tour with refreshing dips along the way. "Koufonisia", meaning hollow islands, were given their name by pirates, as the huge caves convinced them the islands were in fact hollow. Overnight at port.

Day 5

Sail to los island and enjoy a morning swim stop at Magganari Beach, one of the most beautiful sandy beaches in Greece. Lunch onboard. Early afternoon arrival in Santorini for an excursion to Akrotiri prehestoric excavation site and mesmerizing Oia village. Find your perfect dinner spot and experience the world famous Santorini sunset before returning aboard for our overnight sail to Milos island.



Day 6

Morning arrival in the volcanic island of Milos, consistently voted best island in the world. Visit the Geological Mining Museum and the iconic Sarakiniko beach with it milky blue waters and spectacular white rock lunar landscape. In the afternoon we set sail to Kimolos island, a true hidden gem. Dinner on board. Evening at leisure to explore the fairy-tale like chora of Kimolos. Overnight at port.

Day 7

Mid-morning arrival in Sifnos, in the dreamy island of Sifnos, with its traditional white-washed architecture, its famous hiking trails and a sizzling food scene. Hike one of the many "Sifnos trails" or choose an optional excursion to the medieval ancient castle and the most photographed spot of Sifnos, the church of Seven Martyrs. Explore Apollonia, the picturesque capital, named after the God of light Apollo. Opt for a cooking experience with locals or enjoy lunch at one of the many tavernas. As the sun sets and the stars start to fill the night sky, it's time for our special farewell Dinner. Late night we set sail for our return to Athens.

50% penalty for cancellation from 59-30 days prior to departure date

100% penalty for cancellation from 29-00 days prior to departure date

Fares do not Include

Port charges, travel insurance, transfers, optional air/sea or land arrangements (unless otherwise specified), optional shore excursions, airport charges. All onboard charges are in Euros.

Children discounted cruise fares

Children between the ages of 12-15 receive a 50% discount on the cruise fare when sharing a cabin with parents - exclusive of port taxes. The Company regrettably does not accept reservations for children under 12 years old (except on scheduled family cruises).

Solo travelers/single supplement

Solo travelers are more than welcome on the cruise, as the Elysium offers many activities and facilities suitable for all types of travelers. Single supplement is set at 50% over current fares. In addition, the Elysium has a single cabin/no single supplement reserved on priority basis.

Cruise itinerary changes

The carrier reserves the right, at its sole option and discretion and that of the captain of the ship, without liability for damages or refund of any kind, to alter or deviate from the ship's advertised or ordinary itinerary or route due to weather conditions, force majeure, assistance to other ships in distress, saving of life at sea or other extraordinary conditions. Under such extreme circumstances, passengers are not entitled to any claims or refunds. The carrier will however make every effort that passengers access their port of disembarkation on time for their outwards flights.



HEALTH PROTOCOLS

The health and well-being of passengers and crew is our highest priority. The smaller, more intimate size of the Elysium is on its own an assurance of a higher safety level. Due to Covid-19, we are taking additional steps and applying even more rigorous cleaning and disinfecting protocols. We are actively following all Word Health Organization updates regarding Covid-19 and adjust our strategies accordingly, to ensure we meet the latest guidance of hygiene and cleaning.

These are some of the measures applied on board the Elysium.

- Crew members are monitored daily for good health
- UV sterilization of all staterooms and public areas
- Use of approved disinfecting cleaning products effective against viruses
- Strict cleaning and disinfecting protocols are also applied "behind the scenes" in areas like the kitchen, laundry room, crew quarters
- Air management, enhanced filters and other technologies are applied where feasible to ensure fresh air circulation
